

## **Educational Grants Policy**

### **Post-graduate education**

The post-graduate education should demonstrably form a step in the further advancement of the applicant's process in becoming a contributor to the body of evidence as outlined in the bylaws of DBRIC.

Examples of such are: epidemiology courses, statistical analysis courses, Master of Public Health, Master of Education, Master of Biostatistics and similar.

### **Dates for applying:**

May 15 and December 15

### **Budget**

A maximum of 5 grants are awarded per calendar year on a first come, first serve basis after meeting set criteria. A maximum of 1.000 euros are awarded per person per calendar year. In the situation where all grant applications May 15 of a calendar year are approved, there will be no call for grants December 15. In the event that not all grants are awarded within a calendar year, the monies earmarked for this will return to the main budget.
